Château de Rochemorin White 2015

AOC Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France



PRESENTATION

The whites from Château de Rochemorin are astonishing wines. They reveal a particular expression of the Sauvignon grape variety, with its notes of citrus fruit and flowers, finely wooded. Carefully controlled barrel ageing on the lees does not leave its mark on the wines, but enhances the richness of the palate and supports a remarkable range of aromas.

WEATHER CONDITIONS

2015 was the third warmest year since 1900... Drought conditions, above-average monthly temperatures and sunshine (in the first half of the year), cool nights and hot weather in August accompanying véraison (colour change) were all ideal for the vines!

Sauvignon blanc 100%

ALCOHOL CONTENT

14 % vol.

TASTING

This 2015 Rochemorin has a lovely pale yellow colour with lively golden highlights.

The interesting, complex bouquet is very floral, with overtones of white fruit (peach, nectarine, etc.)

This wine is balanced and displays superb acidity as well as elegant white fruit flavours (peach and nectarines) reminiscent of the nose.

FOOD PAIRINGS

It goes beautifully with fish and seafood, quiche, etc.

SERVING

Serve between 9°C and 12°C

AGEING POTENTIAL

5 to 10 years

Deep gravel slopes with limestone outcrops at the foot of the slopes

After settling, in oak barrels.

For 10 months in oak barrels (35% new) on full lees with bâtonnage.
