

Château Grossombre de Saint-Joseph Red 2019

AOC Bordeaux supérieur, Bordeaux, France



PRESENTATION

This remarkable wine immediately attracts one's attention because of its deep reddish-black colour. The bouquet strikes a fine balance between vanilla nuances, smoky aromas and ripe fruit (mainly blackcurrant) overtones. Château Grossombre starts out quite smooth and is altogether generous and well-structured on the palate. Spicy, oaky notes prolong the pleasure of this rich wine that deserves to age.

THE VINTAGE

WEATHER CONDITIONS

2019 was marked by the virtual absence of cold weather in the winter, resulting in earlier bud-break dates in the vineyards. Spring rainfall was scant. A spell of severe drought made itself felt at the start of the summer. The rains in August saved the vines.

HARVEST

24 September - 14 October 2019.

VARIETALS

Cabernet sauvignon 50%, Merlot 50%

ALCOHOL CONTENT

13,5 % vol.

TASTING

A deep ruby red colour that hints at its richness.

The nose is intense and seductive, with generous aromas of black fruits such as blackberries and blackcurrants. Hints of chocolate add an elegant, gourmet touch that invites you to savour the wine. Right from the start, the wine is beautifully supple, enveloping the palate with a pleasant roundness. The freshness is clearly present and harmoniously balances the richness of the black fruit. The wine is light, which makes it particularly pleasant and easy to drink. The finish is marked by a tannic structure that is present but perfectly melted, adding just the right amount of body without weighing the wine down. Average length. Its balance and drinkability make it an excellent choice for a convivial tasting or a meal with friends.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Pork terrine, beef salad with lemongrass, beef bourguignon, chicken with onions.

SERVING

Serve between 13°C and 15°C.

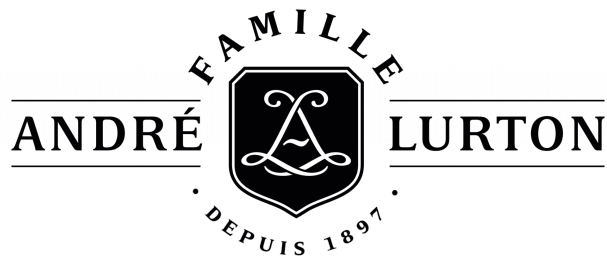
